

BRECON BEACONS NATIONAL PARK



These routes have been developed by Brecon Beacons National Park Authority due to the success of the Three Rivers Ride, that is part of the National Bridleroute Network which was researched & developed by The British Horse Society.

The routes offer full day routes with the option of staying for one or more nights in Bed & Breakfast for horses.

The routes have been tested by riders from areas outside the National Park, some were endurance riders and some leisure riders. All managed to enjoy the routes, however the terrain of the National Park must be taken into consideration as well as the weather and riding experience when estimating the time a route might take.

Parking for horse boxes has been highlighted on the map as well as "horse friendly" pubs. There are several good B&B for horses, some of the proprietors have excellent knowledge of the routes and will be happy to offer their advice & assistance.

It is advisable to take a picnic if you are not planning to stop at a pub for lunch.

Some of the routes will transport horse & rider to the tops of mountains, crossing terrain which requires careful negotiation. The effort in so doing is rewarded by the most spectacular views and a real sense of achievement.

The Yellow Route

18 miles

Suitable for all riders, a nice day route or can be enjoyed at a leisurely pace over two days.

Brown route

13 miles

Suitable for all riders these make either two good day rides but depending on ability both routes could be done in one day, but why hurry! Fantastic picnic spot with spectacular views.

▶ Only ride down, not up

Purple Route

17 miles

Suitable for riders looking for adventure! A good day route would suit more experienced riders.

Red Route

12 miles

Suitable for all riders and a good route to start with. Riders & horses are rewarded by a panoramic 360 degree view, don't forget to take your camera!

Orange Route

34 miles

This is part of the Three Rivers ride route.
